Overview

Saturday, September 11

The Univest Grand Prix is an international professional road cycling competition for men. It is one of only four UCI (*Union Cycliste Internationale*) races on the United States calendar. The race is open to professional and elite amateur teams. The host community embraces the race and shows their support by housing visiting athletes, welcoming cyclists at area schools to speak about their sport, and holding festivals on both days of racing. The Univest Grand Prix Doylestown Criterium is an international circuit race for men held in the heart of Doylestown, the neo-traditional borough and county seat of Bucks County, Pa. Now in its seventh year, the small-circuit event surrounds the annual Doylestown Arts Festival for a complete day of family entertainment.
